









# Ex-Felon Voting Rights for Nebraska Residents

My Legal Status	I have the right to VOTE!	My right to vote has been temporarily suspended
Arrested, awaiting trial for <b>misdemeanor</b> , (in jail or out on bail)		
Convicted of <b>misdemeanor</b> , on probation		
Convicted of <b>misdemeanor</b> , in jail		
Arrested, awaiting trial for <b>felony</b> , (in jail or out on bond)		
Convicted of a <b>felony</b> , currently on probation		
Convicted of a <b>felony</b> , currently in jail or prison		
Convict of <b>felony</b> , out of prison currently on parole		
Convicted of <b>felony</b> (in any state), off paper for at least 2 years

I do not need any documentation to prove my legal status.</p>	<p>Visit any library, DMV, or Election Office to complete a paper application or register online with a state ID or drivers license (NeReg2Vote.org or Vote411.org)</p>
