Voting services include:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Voting by mail. You can have a ballot sent to your home, hospital room, assisted living residence, or long-term care address.2. Voting early in-person at your county election office. Election officials or a friend can help you vote. If you are physically unable to enter the polling place, you can vote curbside.3. Help from an agent to apply for your ballots and deliver them to you.4. Language interpretation at your polling place or for your written ballot.5.
