Provisional Ballot

Provisional ballots are used to record your votes when there is a question about your voter eligibility. This discrepancy must be resolved before your votes are counted.

To avoid this situation, verify your voter registration no later than the third Friday before an election (*see 2022 Key Dates*).

If you receive a provisional ballot at your precinct, verify that it was validated and counted (*see Resource Links*).

Understanding Your Right to Vote

Registered Nonpartisan Voter

- Not affiliated with a political party
- Must request a partisan ballot to vote for primary federal candidates running

Overseas Voters

- Maintain their right to vote – military or temporarily living outside the U.S.
- Participants in the Federal Post Card Application, which registers applicants to vote as well as mails them on Early Voting Ballot.
- Requires early voting request

Homeless

- Have the right to vote
- Addresses that can be used:
 - homeless shelter or day center
 - local Election Commission or County Clerk Office addresses.

Former Felons

- Can vote two years after completing their prison sentence & finished parole
- Must be verified by county clerk, election commissioner, or complete a voter registration.

Individuals with Disabilities

- Technological device is available
- May request assistance on election day from friend, relative or election board member.

Voter Registration

Registering to vote is your civic responsibility and allows you to have a voice. If you plan to vote for the first time – congratulations!

Nebraska allows those who are 17 but turn 18 by the general election on November 8 to vote in the 2022 primary election.

If you have registered in the past but have not voted regularly, it is important to **VERIFY** your registration. Your voter registration is required to be updated when moving, changing names, or changing parties (*see Resource Links*).

Primary Election May 10, 2022

Jan 10, 2022 - 1st day to request early voting ballot for Primary Election.

April 4, 2022—1st day early voting ballots to be mailed.

April 22, 2022 - Last day for voter registration by Online and mail

April 29, 2022 - Last day for voter registration by walk-in.

May 2, 2022– Deadline for early voting ballots to be requested to be mailed.

May 9, 2022 - Last day for early voting at the county clerk or election office.

May 10, 2022—Deadline to return early voting ballots to election commission office or drop box location, 8:00 pm

May 10, 2022 - Statewide Primary Election Day 8am - 8pm (Central Time) - in person voting.

General Election November 8, 2022

July 11, 2022 - First day to accept early voting ballot requests for the General Election.

October 3, 2022—1st day early voting ballots to be mailed.

October 21, 2022 - Last day for voter registration by Online and mail

October 22, 2022 - Last day for voter registration by walk-in.

October 28, 2022– Deadline for early voting ballots to be requested to be mailed.

November 7, 2022 - Last day for early voting at the county clerk or election office.

November 8, 2022—Deadline to return early voting ballots to election commission office or drop box location, 8:00 pm

November 8, 2022 - Statewide Primary Election Day 8am - 8pm (Central Time) - in person voting.
