Dear Senator Brewer and Members of the Government, Military and Veterans Affairs Committee:

The League of Women Voters of Nebraska believes that the people's business should be
conducted in the people's house.

As such, we oppose the provision in LB1068 that would allow the certified presidential electors to
conduct their business at a designated meeting location chosen by the governor. This meeting
should continue to be held at the Nebraska State Capitol as currently specified in Section 1,
Section 32-713, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska.

LB1068 should not advance from the Government, Military and Veterans Affairs Committee.
